

Kyrsten's story is an inspiring example of how dedication, support, and the right opportunities can lead to a fulfilling and impactful career in healthcare.


Student to Caregiver Success

Upward trend in student-to-caregiver conversion

We are pleased to report that over 94% of our affiliated schools have raised their nursing student conversion rates to 50% or higher in 2024!

Thanks to the dedication and excellence of educators at our affiliated schools, we have successfully hired more outstanding students than previous years.

Intermountain Health achieved an impressive 60% conversion rate for capstone nursing students who did rotations at our hospitals. We are excited to continue this upward trend and look forward to welcoming more talented students into our team.
