

Infusion Pump Cleaning Log

Infusion pumps used in Medical Group areas are "W" wiped down between each patient.

A "D" deep clean is needed once a day (or once in a 24-hour period) if the infusion pump is utilized.

- Wiping down the pumps for high-touch cleaning is done with the purple top PDI wipes (2 min dry time) and does not include cleaning the IUI connectors.
- Bleach wipes (4 min dry time) are used for patients with C-diff, Norovirus, and Candia auris. After the appropriate 4 min dry time, the pump is wiped down with a damp • cloth to remove residue.
- Grey top wipes (3 min dry time) are not appropriate for pump cleaning use. ٠
- Ensure dry times are completed before connecting modules to the Point of Care Unit (PCU). .
