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Orthopedic Splinting & Casting



Proper application for orthopedic splinting and casting is essential for avoiding constriction, skin breakdown, altered circulation, altered mobility, secondary injury, and delayed healing.

ORTHOGLASS SPLINT TRAINING PROCESS

Each clinic applying orthoglass should have a super-user. Super-users should be clinical caregivers who are confident & competent to apply splints. If the clinic does not have a super-user, the manager should assign someone to go train with a super-user at a different clinic.

- 1. CAREGIVER: Watch and take notes on all videos listed below.
- 2. MANAGER/RNC/MAC: Assign <u>Orthopedic Splint Quiz</u> to caregiver. A passing score is required before caregivers can move on to the next step.
- 3. SUPER-USER: Instructs caregiver to apply 3 different splints on them (not patients) to ensure they are applying splints correctly.
- 4. SUPER-USER: Watches caregiver apply splints on patients until they feel confident that caregiver is competent.

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5. SUPER-USER/RNC/MAC/MANAGER: Assesses Kahuna competency #2797, Orthopedic Splinting.

Caregivers who have not gone through this process should NOT be applying splints.
