Acting Internships

The Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology welcomes medical students from accredited U.S. or Canadian medical schools who are planning to pursue OB/GYN as a career. The rotations are four weeks long. Students work closely with house staff to ensure sufficient patient contact. Students attend all OB/GYN educational conferences.

We will accept applications starting January 2 through May 1 and will alert all students of their application status before June 1. Rotations begin at the end of June/early July through the end of January.

We accept applications through the <u>VSLO program</u>. Please contact us directly if you have any barriers to applying through this program – in certain circumstances we may accept applications emailed to the program directly. Applicants must have passed Part 1 of the USMLE or COMLEX and must have completed a third year Obstetrics and Gynecology rotation.

For selected students with financial barriers to pursuing "away" rotations, our program offers a scholarship which can aid in reimbursing the costs of housing and transportation. We encourage applicants from low-income backgrounds, first-generation college graduates, students with additional language proficiency, and those who have demonstrated a commitment to service and advocacy for marginalized patient populations. All are welcome to apply for this scholarship by submitting a short paragraph essay (<200 words).

Preference for acting internships is given to candidates with:

- Demonstrated commitment to caring for underserved populations
- Demonstrated commitment to advocacy and leadership
- Spanish language proficiency
