

2024 Quilt Specification Sheet

Thank you for donating quilts to the Holiday Quilt Show and Auction, a bi-yearly fund-raising event for Intermountain Foundation. As you make decisions regarding your quilted donation, please consider the following:

Quilt Top:	Use high quality fabrics. Prewash all cotton fabric to allow for normal shrinkage and to assure dye is stable. Piecing and applique may be done by hand or machine.		
Backing:	Quilt back should be the same quality fabric as the top.		
Batting:	Synthetic fibers, poly/cotton blends, 100% cotton, wool and silk are acceptable. Please remember hand quilting may determine batting choices.		
Quilting:	Quilting must be done by hand, knots l Tied quilts are not accepted.	hand, knots buried, with marking unobtrusive. ed.	
Binding:	Binding should be securely stitched, hand finished using blind hem stitch, and appropriate for the design of the quilt.		
Sleeve:	For wall quilts, a permanent 4" wide (finished) sleeve on the back should match and be sewn in place.		
Labels:	A label is much appreciated and will be enjoyed by the buyer. Please label your quilt with the following: quilt name, size, and the maker's name(s).		
Copyright:	When applicable, please request permission from the designer/publisher to use their pattern for our event. Mention them by name, if possible, on your Quilt History Form.		
Quilt Sizes / Types:	We accept a variety of quilt types and sizes for our Show and Auction. This variety is good not only for those who make the quilts, but for future buyers.		
	Consider: traditional, contemporary, crib, wall, sofa, throw, miniature, whimsical, etc.		
	The following is only a partial list of traditional quilt sizes for your reference (all are approximate):		
	Crib 45" x 60" Throw 50" x 70" Twin 72" x 90" Twin Long 72" x 101"	Full 78" x 101" Queen 92" x 108" King 108" x 108"
